Children's Room Renovation:

- Temporary Children's room will be closed from Wednesday Friday while staff is moving the books upstairs to the renovated Children's room.
- Trustees, Terri and Connie took a sneak peak of the renovated Children's Room. Everyone was thrilled with the vibrant creative colorful wall mural, floor covering, low shelfing, furniture, table train, puppet theater and interactive discovery panels.
