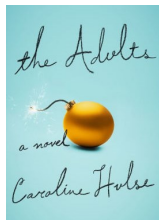




Unusual Holiday Reads



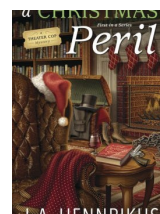

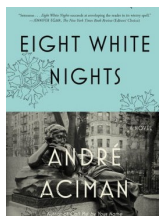
A Christmas Day at the Office by **Matt Dunn (2016)** One Christmas party. Two merging companies. Free-flowing champagne. What could possibly go wrong?

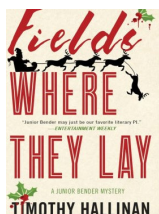

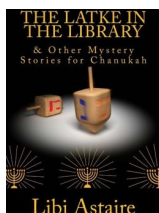
