TPL is Going Fine Free

Say Hello to Fewer Overdue Fines

Thayer Public Library is permanently going fine-free starting **May 1, 2022**!

The Library had already suspended late fees at the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the Trustees of Thayer Public Library voted to continue the fine free status permanently.

Fine free applies to materials owned by Thayer Public Library, with the following exceptions: Library of Things/ Equipment, Museum Passes, Baker & Taylor collection (items with a red "B&T" sticker on the spine), and materials from outside of the OCLN Library System. Fees for lost, damaged, and never-returned items will still be charged to accounts.

Fines are different at each OCLN library and are still subject to the lending policies of the owning library, including overdue fees.

If you changed your email address recently and have not been receiving notifications from OCLN, please stop by or call (781-848-0405, ext. 4410) the Circulation Department to update your account.
