

December Newly Released Movie



Each month we show a newly released on DVD movie on the library's big screen! Join us this month on **Wednesday**, **December 7th** for a showing of *The Duke*, starring Jim Broadbent and Helen Mirren.

The first showing is at 2:00 pm and the second showing at 6:30 pm in Logan Auditorium on the Upper Level of the library.

In 1961, Kempton Bunton, a 60-year old taxi driver, stole Goya's portrait of the Duke of Wellington from the National Gallery in London. Or did he? It was the first (and remains the only) theft in the Gallery's history. Kempton sent ransom

notes saying that he would return the painting on condition that the government invested more in care for the elderly -- he had long campaigned for pensioners to receive free television. What happened next became the stuff of legend. Only 50 years later did the full story emerge -- Kempton had spun a web of lies. The only truth was that he was a good man, determined to change the world and save his marriage -- how and why he used the Duke to achieve that is a wonderfully uplifting tale. And this is based on a true story that has become legend in Great Britain!

Admission is limited to the first 100 people. This program is intended for adult audiences.
