

Changes to Kanopy

Starting November 1, 2023, the viewing experience on Kanopy will be easier than ever with the switch from play credits to tickets. With this update, you can easily see the number of tickets required and viewing period for each film next to the play button.



Every title will be labeled with a ticket value and viewing time frame. Videos that are two hours or less will require two tickets and will be available for three days. Those from two to four hours will be three tickets and will be available for three days. Four to six hour programs will require four tickets and be checked out for seven days. Anything that is six or more hours will require five tickets and be checked out from 14 to 21 days.

Kanopy Kids: Kanopy Kids content will continue to be its own section on Kanopy and will not be included in the ticket system.
