Public Internet Computer Upgrade

We are excited to be upgrading all of our public internet computers! The new computers will offer Windows 11 with enhanced security and the same productivity software that you are accustomed to using.

We are also introducing new printing and time management software. The date of the upgrade has yet to be finalized, and computers and printing may not be available for up to two weeks. **The tentative timeline for the computer upgrade is February 18th through 28th.**



During this time, Chromebooks (in-library use only) will still be available for checkout, so remember to bring your library card. Sorry, the Chromebooks will not have printing capability until the new print software is operational.

Chromebooks are perfect for using a Google account to access Google's web-based suite of applications which includes word processing, spreadsheets, slide presentations and more.

Want to learn more about free Google products? You can take an online training course through Gale Courses to learn about Google's many free applications on the web and how to put them to work for business, hobbies, and personal projects. Six week, instructor-led classes start monthly. The next Google Workspace class starts Wednesday, February 12th.

Prefer to learn with on demand streaming video? We have you covered! Niche Academy has a tutorial on *Using a Chromebook,* as well as lessons on other Google products. And Gale Presents: Udemy also offers lectures and courses to help you learn how to get the most out of Google products.
